TOPIC: *An IFMA Foundation Update*

Stephen Ballesty, CFM, MRICS, FAIQS, ICECA, Rider Levett Bucknall & IFMA Foundation

Stephen Ballesty is the Sydney based Director and Head of Advisory for global consulting firm, Rider Levett Bucknall. He is an RICS Chartered FM Surveyor and was FMA Australia's first recipient of IFMA's Certifier Facility Manager (CFM) designation. He is a former national Director and Past Chairman of the Facility Management Association of Australia and former Deputy Chairman of the Australian Government's FM Action Agenda. In 2007 he joined the Board of the IFMA Foundation, and in July 2010 was elected their global Chairman. Stephen is not only the IFMA Foundation's first Asia / Oceania representative but is the first non North American to hold the chair.



TOPIC: *Development of Greywater Recycling and its Potential Applications in HK*

Although the water supply agreement with Guangdong has secured a stable supply of Dongjiang water to Hong Kong, we cannot forget that Hong Kong is in fact short of fresh water and used to suffer from severe water rationing. To prepare for the declining rainfall due to climate change and the rapidly increasing water demand in the Pearl River Delta region, the Government has formulated a Total Water Management (TWM) strategy. One of the key initiatives under the TWM strategy is to actively consider water reclamation, like reuse of greywater. In this technical meeting, Dr. Ma will share with the audience the development of greywater recycling in overseas, mainland China and Hong Kong. He will also explain the potentials and major constraints influencing the applications of greywater recycling in Hong Kong, and will use the case in the City University to illustrate how these constraints can be overcome.

Dr Anthony Ma, CIWEM HK

Dr Ma is the Principal Consultant of the Hong Kong Productivity Council (HKPC) in charge of the water and wastewater projects. He has 22 years of experience in water pollution control, water purification, water reclamation and water efficiency consultancy. He is highly experienced in developing and applying innovative treatment technologies in water and wastewater treatment. Dr Ma got his first and second degrees from the University of Hong Kong, and his PhD degree in chemical engineering from the Queen's University of Belfast, UK. He is the Chairman of the Chartered Institution of Water and Environmental Management Hong Kong (CIWEM HK), a UK-based leading professional body of environmental scientists, engineers and professionals. He is also the Voluntary Advisor of Oxfam Hong Kong.
