*What are **accessible premises**? And are your premises accessible for all?*

Access is a means to enable people, with or without a disability, to approach, enter or leave premises, and to reach and use all facilities and services that the premises offer without undue difficulties.

- Learn the importance of ensuring your premises to be **accessible**.
- Understand why your premises may be inaccessible.
- Identify and evaluate the operational, physical and attitudinal barriers in your premises.
- Avoid complaints and litigation against you due to access barriers.
