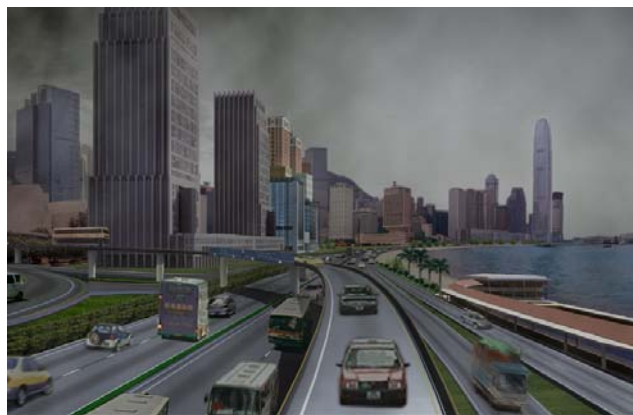


AGM and Chapter Network Lunch “Where is Our Harbour Now?”
