THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF CENTRAL



Since the founding of Hong Kong in 1842, Central has been the focus of business, finance and government. Its boundary has expanded through organic growth and successive reclamations, and now covers some 129 ha of prime land.

With the majority of Central having been developed, the presentation attempts to explore how Central will develop in order to maintain its status as the business and political centre of Hong Kong. In particular, focus will be given to the waterfront sites in the Central and Wanchai Reclamation. References will be made to the outline zoning plans, publications by government and market intelligence.
