RICS Membership through Assessment of Professional Competence (APC)

APC (Assessment of Professional Competence) is the structured training period carried out by candidates who have graduated with an RICS-approved degree and have commenced employment. Through the APC, including the period of structured training and professional assessment, those who have an acceptable level of competence in carrying out the work of a professionally qualified surveyor are admitted to Professional Membership.

You may apply the RICS membership through the senior professional route:

A surveying related 1 st degree and surveying related higher degree OR PhD in a surveying related subject	5 years' surveying experience since graduation from a 2 nd degree and now in a senior industry position OR 5 years' surveying experience since completion of PhD and now in a senior industry position
