IFMA Chapter Site Visit International Commerce Centre 5 July 2008, Saturday

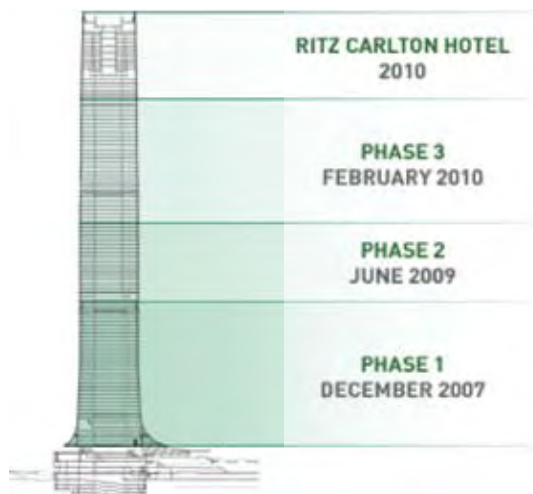
IFMA members are invited to visit this latest skyscraper - International Commerce Centre.



International Commerce Centre (ICC) - A unique development featuring a cutting-edge commercial space, luxury residential development, modern retail and two 6-star hotels in a single location. This is not just a business address, but a destination – offering to Hong Kong a single location in which to live, work and play, within reach of locals and visitors alike by virtue of being located on major rail lines.

At 490 metres above sea level, the 118-floor ICC will be Hong Kong's tallest building and the world's third tallest (in terms of usable floors). ICC will be completed in phases from 2007 to 2010. When complete, ICC will comprise of 2.5 million square feet of Grade - A offices, a 1 million square feet shopping mall - Elements, luxury residences and serviced apartments. This Hong Kong's tallest tower will also feature a one-of-a-kind observation deck at its summit, offering 360-degree views of Hong Kong's famous skyline.

The visit begins with an overview of the project presented by the development team, followed by a guided tour visiting areas including the furnished floors, plant rooms etc.
