

Chapter CPD Evening Seminar “Engaging the China FM Market”



Mr. Kit Tuveson, CFM, IFMA Fellow, will be presenting his views on Facility Management from an International perspective. He will define an FM Market in terms of six necessary components, and then will propose a methodology for assessing the maturity of such FM Markets. The application of that model will be used to focus on the FM Market in China, and the opportunities and challenges of working in Mainland China. Kit will also share his global FM experiences with Hewlett-Packard, including China. He will finish his presentation with a scenario model of how China might grow in the future - "The Four Futures of China".

Kit is a Facility Management Consultant, with 30 years of FM practitioner and leadership experience. He has his Bachelors in Electrical Engineering and Masters in Industrial Engineering, both from Stanford University. In 2002, he "graduated" from HP after a 36 year career in Manufacturing and FM. He finished his HP career as Global Director of Environmental Health & Safety. He is a Past Chairman of IFMA, is the current First VP of the FM Consultants Council, and continues to actively serve the Association as an IFMA Fellow.
